1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by writing to us.
2. If you stop being a taxpayer it is IMPORTANT you tell us so we stop claiming tax (or if you no longer pay enough tax – again you must tell us)
3. Married couples: each spouse should complete a separate Gift Aid Declaration
4. Please tell us if you change your name or address
5. If you are a higher-rate tax payer you can claim back the higher rate tax via your tax return (potentially £000s)
We only claim back the basic rate tax
6. If you are unsure whether you pay enough tax to complete this form please ask us – or refer to HMRC leaflet IR65 available at www.hmrc.gov.uk or from your local tax office

*Under Gift Aid we claim back basic rate tax (currently 25p in the £1). However the Government will also pay us an extra 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 & 5 April 2011. This is called "transitional relief". It is not a refund of tax you have paid so does not affect the calculation of how much you can give under Gift Aid, nor does it affect your personal tax position.
